I wish to continue sharing information with you from The Strategic Plan which can be accessed on the National website, NARFE.org. Log in and click on The Strategic Plan banner for a PDF version or call me for a paper copy. In April I provided you part of the "Executive Summary"; here is another portion of that summary found on page five:

B. Bolster NARFE's brand to increase awareness, eliminate confusion, and convey the value of NARFE.

Strategy 1. Convert Knowledge Gained Through Market Research into Action.

Market research has recently been conducted with current and potential NARFE members to provide insight into the perceptions, preferences, and unfilled needs of the next generation of potential NARFE members. The information collected should guide changes in marketing the organization at large and meeting the needs of the membership.

C. Stabilize and grow membership to support effective advocacy and to deliver financial stability

Strategy 1. Optional Chapter Membership

Current and new NARFE members will be members of the national organization and will have the option to join a chapter of their choice at any time.

Strategy 2. Expand outreach to prospective members

Strengthen the existing program to further communicate the value of NARFE to prospective members.

Strategy 3. Engage members

Emphasize importance of advocacy and support of NARFE mission.

We must remember that we can do things as individual members of NARFE. May I suggest you recruit a new member: give a gift subscription to a former coworker or your eligible children or grandchildren; or encourage a member who has dropped for non-renewal of dues to renew their membership. NARFE would like you to show support for H.R. 711, the **"Equal Treatment of Public Servants Act of 2015"**.

I contacted Stasha Dennard of Congressman Kilmer's Bremerton office prior to our last General Membership meeting to let her know of our meeting date, time and place. I mentioned H.R. 711 to her and she came to our meeting prepared to address the group to express Congressman Kilmer's position on this piece of legislation.

I am pleased to report that Congressman Kilmer is now a bill co-sponsor. He signified his co-sponsorship on 25 May 2016. The bill now has 62 Republican and 38 Democrat co-sponsors.

Thank you for expressing support of this bill to Congressman Kilmer's office. It is nice to have a small success.

MEMBERSHIP

This is where I give you some statistics with my "Membership Recruitment" information. You may see it as whining and crying but, the fact is, I am not in control here. But we as a chapter are, and should be, in control of the membership recruiting. Our membership has dropped from 1031 voting members at the end of April 2012 to 673 voting members at the end of April 2016. For the first four months of this year we lost an average of 5.75 members per month for non-payment of dues; in the same four months we recruited and reinstated an average of one member per month and 2.25 members per month respectively. I realize that we get busy, change our address or just don't get our dues paid, **but your membership is vital to the mission of NARFE.** In the next newsletter I will give you a summation of "what has NARFE done for me lately, exactly what are my dues doing for me and what is my responsibility to our organization".
